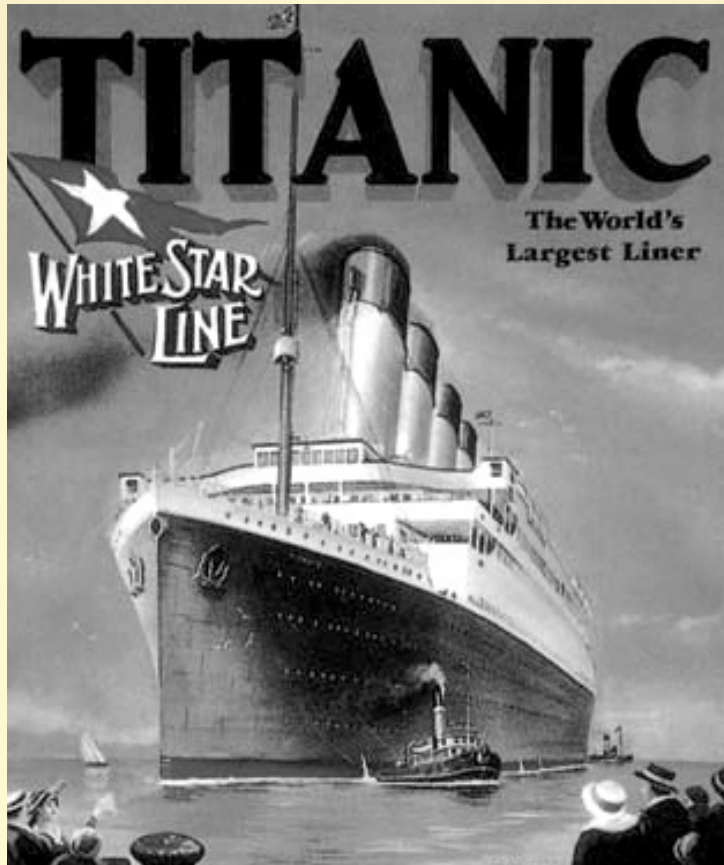
### A TITANIC TEA
